



   administrative capacity of the Albanian institutions to enforce the
   relevant Union acquis

# Summary: from 01.10.2020 until present

Due to the emergency situation caused by Covid-19, all the activities implemented during the 1st Quarterly were carried out by remote and all the planned activities in the next months are planned to be implemented by remote with on-line sessions according to the specific Agenda of each activity

- Project duration: 01.10.2020 30.09.2021 (12 months, 5<sup>th</sup> month on-going)
- Budget: 400.000 €
- RTA commenced his assignment on 1st October 2020, IDP premises project office
- Agreed methodology with CFCU for the implementation of the missions activities by remote (Agenda, MR and MC), according to the Twinning Manual defined
- Initial Work Plan (12 months) and Communication and Visibility Plan approved during 1 SCM (January 14<sup>th</sup> 2021)
- 9 experts involved, 61,5 working days carried out, 4 Side letters submitted and 1 under preparation for re-allocation of the savings

# Our missions/activities

















## **Component 1**

#### Alignment of national legislation with the GDPR and the Police Directive (57 m/d)

- With specific SLs, MS and BC recognised the necessity to start all the activities under C1 before the finalization of the Initial Work Plan
  - The Parliamentary Elections in the Republic of Albania will take place on April 25th 2021
  - Specific need to receive the specific recommendations for amending the current national legislation in line with the EU General Data Protection Regulation and the Police Directive in order to be able to submit the draft legislation to the Parliament on time

#### Activities & Mandatory results

- 1.1: Amendment of national legislation in line with the EU General Data Protection Regulation and the Police Directive will be completed within the 3°IQR. A first advanced draft of the Law has been already consolidated
- 1.2: Comparative reviews and analysis of the Albanian data protection legislation in force with the GDPR and the Police Directive, completed in the 1QR
- **1.3**: Initial findings and recommendations for the preparation of the draft of the new law on personal data protection, **completed** in the 1QR
- 1.4: Strategy for alignment of the Albanian legal framework on personal data protection with the EU General Data Protection Regulation and the Police Directive has been completed in the 2°IQR
- 1.5: Preparation of number of sub-legal acts on data protection is expected to be completed within the 3°IQR

# **Component 2**

#### Capacity building for enforcement of the new Data Protection legal framework (48 m/d)

- Activities & Mandatory results
  - **2.1**: Training of the relevant staff of the IDP Commissioner on new data protection framework (train the trainers) **on-going** 
    - Definition of the training objectives through the KSA (Knowledge, Skill and Attitude) approach
    - Performing a Training Need Analysis (TNA) Questionnaires
    - Training program design
    - Training delivery
  - **2.2**: Increasing of the Administrative capacities on the practical enforcement of Data Protection legislation, (February- June 2021)
    - Identification of the specific personnel to be involved
    - Definition of specific coaching programmes based on on-the-field case experience
    - Delivery of dedicated coaching activities
    - Final evaluation, based on satisfaction questionnaire
  - 2.3: Providing capacity building activities for the staff of IDP Commissioner's Office, SV (May July 2021)

# **Component 3**

# Awareness-raising with controllers and processors in order to ensure that they comply with the new Data Protection Law (49 m/d)

- Activities & Mandatory results
  - 3.1: Raising the awareness of Controllers and processors of the Data Protection Law (March June 2021)
    - Definition of a common baseline of knowledge to be disseminated and identifying specific contents for each specific sector (public, private, civil society)
    - Preparation of specific programmes for trainings and workshops dissemination activities
  - **2.2**: Raising the awareness of controllers and processors on the novelties and introductions of the Data Protection law (May August 2021)
    - Delivery of 3 seminars for the Public sector, 1 seminar for School of Magistrates to judges and prosecutors, 3 dissemination events for private sector, 1 dissemination event for Civil Society
    - Final assessment based on questionnaire results
  - **2.3**: Providing assistance in drafting new guidelines for controllers and processors (May August 2021)
    - Analysis and collection needs and requests, considering the new trends at European and International level about Personal Data Protection Legislation;
    - Definition of specific approach based on concrete a practical cases
    - Preparation of guidelines

## **Overall Assessment**

- State of the implementation meets the expectations for Components and it is in line with the planned activities of the Twinning Contract and also proposed in the Initial Work Plan
- Project has been running smoothly and also anticipating the execution of the
  activities under the Component 1, in order to satisfy the request from BC to receive
  in time the proposal for the new Law of Personal Data to be presented to Albanian
  Parliament before the elections
- Mutual working relationships between MS and BC are active and very positive so
  far, confirming the spirit of peer-to-peer key principles of the twinning methodology
  (dropbox as real time tool)
- **Full commitment** and support by **IDP** to cooperate and to benefit as much as possible from the TA and expertise provided by MS in the framework of the project
- Contribution and the availability provided by the MS experts during the implementation of the project activities even if when not formally involved
- Progress achieved so far is satisfactory, despite the collaboration and remote approach due to Covid-19, which limits somehow the direct synergies and the real presence
